

1. Adaptive Diagnostic;

Students see questions based on how they are performing.
2. Online instruction is personalized to the individual;

Each student has their own pathway based on diagnostic results.
3. i-Ready is NOT a grading tool;
i-Ready is used to help students grow, but it is not used to assign grades.
4. i-Ready does NOT Replace Classroom Teachers;
i-Ready supports teachers by helping group students for targeted instruction/differentiation. The Teacher Toolbox is one of many resources that teachers may use to provide targeted instruction.
