Results from 2021–2022 may reflect the continued effects of the COVID-19 pandemic on student performance.

Noteworthy Data Points

- 3 students on target in ELA
- 1 student on target in Science
- 8 students approaching target in ELA
- 6 students approaching target in Math

Focal Area Data Points

- Lack of students meeting the target in all areas
- Students in 3rd and 4th grade were emerging on all subjects
- 11th grade students did not meet the target in either content

Responses to the Focal Area Data Points

- Grant funding allowed for a coach to work with staff virtually (2020-21 SY) and in person (2021-22 SY) to increase staff capacity on the modification of the curriculum
- Coach is currently working with curriculum supervisors to develop documents that embed the Essential Elements within curriculum documents for teacher planning.
- Coach working with curriculum supervisors to develop modified local assessments for data collection on the response to instruction and progress on the modified curriculum.
